Tuesday 20th August 2019

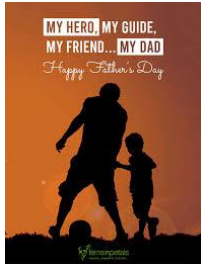
In exchange for wearing pyjamas, students are asked to make a \$2 donation.

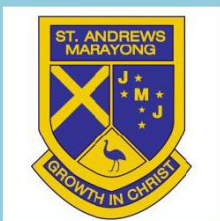

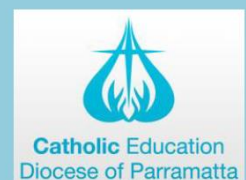

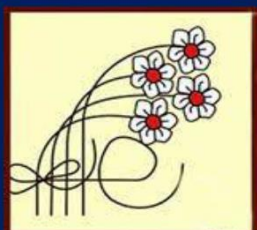
