Parramatta has the honour of being the site of the first Catholic school in not only Sydney, but Australia. The school was founded in October 1820 by Irish Catholic Priest Fr John Therry and run by convict and lay person George Marley. The school was believed to be in Hunter Street, Parramatta and taught 31 students.

We have come a long way from these humble beginnings. Parramatta Diocese currently consists of eighty primary and secondary schools, preschools, before and after school care options, diverse needs settings and post school options. It is fitting that in 2023 our families have so many enrolment options.

As a community we can be proud of Our Lady of The Way. A primary school that has educated students in the Emu Plains area since 1979 and is still going strong.

Year One




In Year One this term we have hit the ground running with our focus and engagement for learning. We are loving being in our new space where 'every day is paradise in Year One!'






Maths





Welcome back! The shelves are brimming with Australia's best children's books, as well as favorites from overseas authors.





Valuables

Valuable toys and equipment should not be brought to school. Children are encouraged to bring small inexpensive items to play with such as a tennis ball, skipping rope, small toy car or the like.

Students are NOT PERMITTED to have mobile phones at school. If your child requires their phone for after school (ie as emergency contact) they will need to drop their phone into the front office when they arrive at school and pick it up at the end of the day. The phone will be the responsibility of the student.

Students are not to wear smartwatches that have photo, video or phone capabilities. These watches are causing a distraction to valuable learning time and breach child protection protocols.

Lost Property

There are lost property bins located outside the clothing pool (next to the Music Room). Please ensure that all your child's property is clearly labelled. The chances of the lost item finding its way back to its owner are significantly increased if items are labelled clearly. Items unclaimed after four weeks will be given to the clothing pool.

Extended Leave Protocol

Parents wishing to take their child out of school for family holidays for 5 or more days need to complete an extended leave application *prior* to your child going on leave. Please give at least 2 weeks' notice. Once the application is received by the office a certificate of approval will be sent home with your child.


ZONE SWIMMING UPDATE


