PRINICIPAL'S MESSAGE

Welcome to Term 2!



I hope all our families enjoyed the Easter break. Easter was a time for Catholics to demonstrate their gratitude for Jesus' ultimate sacrifice. Jesus gave his life for us so we will experience the ultimate gift of eternal life in heaven. Jesus demonstrated his unconditional love for us. This is a message we can all work to emulate in our own lives.

On Monday the staff participated in;

- mandatory CPR, asthma and anaphylaxis training. The training is compulsory for all staff to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all students.
- professional learning which refined staff understanding of student personalised learning.
 Teachers are required to differentiate learning to meet the needs of all students in their care.
 This is a complex task that requires teachers to know their students and apply proven strategies to extend student learning.

The day provided staff with the time required to reflect on individual student needs in preparation for the new term.

Positive Behaviour Support for Learning (PBS4L)

This term we are relaunching many aspects of our PBS4L student management system. This relaunch captures our refined thinking which is based on previous years data, staff reflective processes, discussions with students and an opportunity for parent input.

I encourage all parents to read and familiarise themselves with the attached PBS4L information booklet. The staff have spent considerable time today with students to help them understand our new processes.

Asthma and Anaphylaxis Update to School Procedures

We are making changes to how asthma puffers and EpiPens are stored at school. These changes are in line with current first aid training and will ensure medication is readily available should the need arise.

Moving forward -

Students with asthma will be required to store their medication:

• in their school bag for asthma puffers (a bag, with their name, will be provided for their puffers/spacer and action plan)

Students with anaphylaxis will be required to store their medication:

in a school provided bag which will have their name on it. Students will be required to wear
this bag at all times when they leave their classroom.

Students with asthma should have their puffer with them when participating in physical activity whilst students with anaphylaxis should always have their EpiPen on their person. Our new process will support this thinking.

Parents of students who have a current medical action plan will receive an email detailing these changes and the need to discuss them with their child. Student puffers and EpiPens currently stored in the school office will be distributed to students.

The school will continue to keep emergency asthma puffers and EpiPens at school.

Sport

This term we have made changes to how sport is taught at Our Lady of The Way. In the business of the end of term this was not adequately communicated to families and for that I apologise.

Students are required to spend one and a half hours a week meeting the outcomes of the Personal Development, Health and Physical Education Syllabus. The syllabus is comprised of six components of which half contain physical activity. This means that the time engaged in physical activity per week at school is one hour. Whilst I accept that some parents will not be happy with this, this is the amount of time set by NESA - not the school. Any additional time would impact our ability to meet required hours dedicated to other learning areas such as English and Mathematics. As a school we are audited and therefore must ensure we meet the required teaching time for all learning areas.

We have also reviewed the number of external providers being used to teach sport. These have been at the expense of families and whilst essential for some sporting activities, such as gymnastics and dance, they should not occur every term and should not take up additional teaching hours.

We have made the decision to focus on obtaining government grants available to schools to provide specialised coaches throughout the year to support teachers as they meet the PDHPE syllabus outcomes. This will not occur every term for every student.

From this term students will participate in sport *once* a week as per the parent communication term 1 week 11 newsletter.
