Year 1 and Year 6 will be attending the last Friday Parish Mass for this term this Friday June 16 @ 9:00am. You are very welcome to attend.



WELLBEING COUNSELLOR MESSAGE

Empathic Emotion Coaching Cheat Sheet



- Adaptive ways of coping with emotions
- emotions



Identify the child's emotional state

Listen to their words or use your observations of their behaviour. Remember. behaviour is a form of communication and can indicate that the child is struggling with intense emotions.

Use a stem statement to start the conversation & listen with empathy

- You look pretty _____, is that right? Can you tell me why?
- Based on your face, you're looking like you might be feeling , what's happened?
- It seems like you're _____, can you tell me why?



Validate their feelings & help the child label the emotion with words

- It must be tough to be feeling this way.
- Thank you for being honest about how you feel.
- That would make me feel _____ too.

This is such an important part of developing children's emotions; you are teaching them the words to express themselves! You've already reflected their emotions, now it's their turn to identify the emotions themselves with some prompting and reflection from you.



They need to NAME the emotion to be able to TAME the emotion.

Set limits as appropriate & explore problem solving together Set limits ESPECIALLY around safety or property damage.

• It's ok to be angry, BUT it's never ok to hit/kick/yell/punch/break items

Problem solve together about what they can do to regulate their emotions, solve peer conflict, or make reparations. Don't give them all the answers, work as a team so they can develop their independent emotion regulation skills.

Don't forget to ... TEACH, PRACTICE, FEEDBACK
